# STT InfoShare 2.2

STT InfoShare is a separately licensed deployment solution that integrates seamlessly with STT Trainer to provide learners with training content according to their role in your organization, and managers with detailed web-based reports on training effectiveness and progress.

STT InfoShare is a web-based application with some Windows configuration components that you have to install on the server computer that will host your STT InfoShare site.

Managers and learners only need a computer with an internet connection and Internet Explorer 6 or above to use STT InfoShare. STT InfoShare can be used in conjunction with STT Help, in which case managers and learners also need to install STT Help. Refer to the *Learner Environment* section for the minimum and recommended requirements for STT Help.

*Note: STT InfoShare 2.1 is only compatible with STT Trainer 5.0 and later.*
